Detroit Testing Laboratory, Inc., a leading automotive and industrial testing and development laboratory, announces that on November 13, 2006, the company's metallurgical testing resources were sold to Stork Climax Research Services, Inc. in Wixom, Michigan and metallurgical services will be provided to DTL by Stork on an ongoing basis.

The sale and transfer of the metallurgical test activity, which accounted for approximately 3% of DTL's overall sales, was facilitated as part of a strategic business decision for Detroit Testing Laboratory to continue its increased focus on the rapidly expanding automotive product and component testing divisions, including non-metals materials testing, vehicle and electrical/mechanical component testing, and fuel system testing.

Chairman and CEO, Alfredo Apolloni stated, "the metallurgical department at DTL has provided metallurgical testing, failure analysis and consulting services with a strong focus on the U.S. automotive industry since DTL's establishment in 1903. As DTL has expanded our services in the testing of automotive products and components, we concluded that there would be a better strategic fit for our metallurgical business with a company that was focused on this market segment."

Detroit Testing Laboratory, Inc.'s plans to reinvest the proceeds from this sale into new state of the art testing technology within it's new 80,000 square foot technical center. DTL's new headquarters and technical center is located at 27485 George Merrelli Drive in Warren, Michigan.
